Residents and people who work in the The City of Effingham or within Effingham County are encouraged to enroll now either by calling 217-203-9758, or by going to the website Hyper-Reach allows individual citizens to receive alerts for their home, office and for other addresses they care about such as those of elderly relatives, or friends.

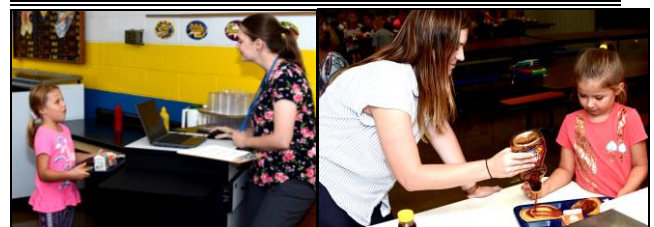
AMAZONSMILE & OFFICE DEPOT PROGRAMS

ABSENCES AND TARDIES

Children will be counted tardy for any absence of less than 1 hour during the school day. This can be coming in late, or leaving early. An absence of 1-3 hours will be counted as half day absent. An absence of more than 3 hours will be counted as absent for the entire day. Perfect attendance means no tardies or absences for half or whole day. All students need to sign in/out at the school office when leaving early or arriving late during the school day. **Remember to call the school office (618-483-6428) by 8:10am if your student will not be at school and you haven't sent a note in advance to their homeroom teacher. Please leave a message on the answering machine if it's before school hours, or no one answers.**
