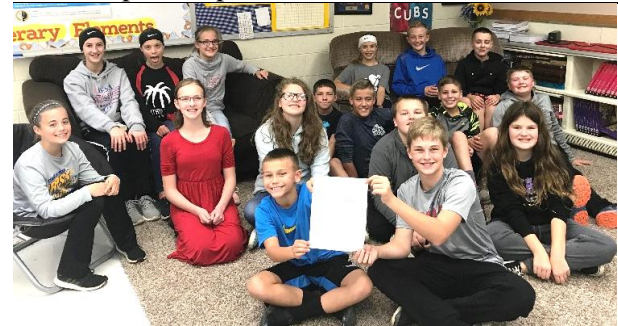
## **PTL WALK-A-THON THANK YOU**
